

RESOLUTION DETERMINING INITIAL VIEW
OF LEGISLATIVE BODY THAT DEBT LIMITA-
TION WILL NOT BE EXCEEDED NO. 2492

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento did, on the 15th day of May, 1942, adopt its Resolution No. 2492 entitled "Preliminary Determination of Legislative Body Under Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, the 'Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931;'"

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED by said City Council that it is the initial view of this Council that the contemplated improvement described in said Resolution No. 2492 above referred to is one in which the probable assessments will not exceed the limitations set up by said Act above referred to;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Clerk of this Council is hereby ordered and directed to give notice of the contemplated action of this Council by mailing to interested property owners a "Notice of Proposed Assessment" in the time, form and manner, and to the persons, all as provided in said Act above referred to.

RESOLUTION No. 2492

RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY
UNDER DIVISION 4 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, THE
"SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND
MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2492

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection therewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving

8TH AVENUE, from a point 95 feet east of the easterly curb line of Riverside Boulevard, to a point 737 feet easterly therefrom; by removing and disposing of all surplus and refuse material; grading; and constructing concrete sidewalk $3\frac{1}{2}$ " in thickness and 4 feet in width on official line and grade where the same does not exist on official line and grade.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

on the north by the northerly boundary of "Riverside Park" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); on the south by the southerly boundary of said subdivision; on the east by a line commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 63 in said subdivision; thence to the southeast corner of said Lot 63; thence to the northeast corner of Lot 11 in said subdivision; thence to the southeast corner of said Lot 11; and on the west by a line commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 75 in said subdivision; thence to the southwest corner of said Lot 75; thence to a point on the south line of 8th Avenue, said point being 46.10 feet from the northwest corner of Lot 1 in said subdivision; thence southerly at right angles, 74.66 feet to a point; thence westerly at right angles, 24.10 feet

to a point; thence southerly at right angles, 80 feet to the southerly boundary of said subdivision.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Act of 1911;" with bonds to be issued as authorized under Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," said bonds to bear interest at the rate of five (5 %) per cent per annum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grades as shown on said plans be, and the same are, hereby adopted as the official grades; and


