

## RESOLUTION No. 205

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

August 8th, 1929

WHEREAS, the City sold to Greer and Harrigan two lots purchased by it at delinquent tax sale, and

WHEREAS, a title company reports that a suit to quiet title must be had before the City can give good title to said lots, and

WHEREAS, the City agreed to give good title,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Attorney bring, in the name of the City of Sacramento, actions to quiet the title to these two lots; and he is hereby given such power and authority.

Said lots are described as follows:

"All that real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as Lots Nos. 2419 and 2504, as shown on the "Map No. 2 of Elmhurst" recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, May 19, 1910, in Book of Maps, Map No. 30."
