AGAINST PERS PROPOSED SITE SELECTION

WHEREAS, the proposed building to accommodate Public Employee Retirement System/State Teachers Retirement System employees represents a major project with significant environmental and social impact; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has recently adopted a community plan and proposed zoning including sites identified as probable locations for the PERS project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project on the identified sites would be wholly incompatible with the community plan and proposed zoning as well as current zoning, thereby potentially creating severe conflict with the efforts of the City of Sacramento to reasonably plan its future, manage growth, and accommodate the needs of all segments of the community; and

WHEREAS, a critical need exists to harmonize the actions of the State of California which have an impact on the City of Sacramento with the efforts and plans of the City to provide a high quality of life for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Impact Report on the PERS project fails to consider adequately alternative sites or variations of the project which would achieve the harmony sought between the actions of the State and the efforts of the City; and

WHEREAS, there has been no open, public hearing before a body with decision-making authority on the proposed project in which those affected have enjoyed an opportunity to appear and be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento requests the PERS Board to conduct an open, public hearing to which those affected by the proposed project receive notice and at which public testimony is permitted;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Sacramento requests the PERS Board to delay approving any proposed project on any site until further investigation and analysis into alternative locations for or variations of the proposed project in the downtown area can be completed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be transmitted to members of the PERS Board.
