

Resolution of Award No. 2432

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 6th day of June, 1941, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **E. F. Hilliard**

at the prices specified in his proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **WESTERLY SIDE 15TH STREET**, from the southerly line of "S" Street, to a point 17.25 feet south of the northerly line of "T" Street; and **NORTHERLY SIDE "T" STREET**, from the westerly line of 15th Street, to a point 160 feet westerly therefrom,

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2432, passed and adopted by said City Council on April 25, 1941, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the "Sacramento Union," a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
