

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO
MARCH 2 1939.

The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date, at the hour of 9:10 o'clock A.M. MAYOR TOM B. MONK presiding and Roll Call answered by the following:

Councilmen Anderson, Arnold, Bidwell, Coughlin, Harry, Kunz, Monk, Welsh.

ABSENT: Councilman Truesdale.

Call for the Meeting was ordered filed.

The purpose of the Meeting being the designation of a meeting place for the next regular meeting of the City Council and to consider any other matters which might be presented.

Councilman Harry introduced the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 597 CITY COUNCIL

"WHEREAS, the City Council at its last regular meeting in the Supervisors Room at the Court House adopted a motion to hold its next regular meeting in the Council Chamber; and

"WHEREAS, said Council Chamber is not ready for occupancy as a place for a regular meeting

"NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the said action of the City Council be rescinded and that the regular meeting of March 3rd, 1939 be held at the said Supervisor's Room in the County Court House."

Councilman Harry moved that foregoing Resolution be adopted.
