### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING: AMERICAN RIVER WATERSHED SANITARY SURVEY UPDATE**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The California Surface Water Treatment Rule requires the completion of an update to the American River Watershed Sanitary Survey by December 2008.
- B. City staff has worked with ten other municipal water purveyors to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that provides a cost effective approach to partner together to complete the watershed sanitary survey update requirement.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with California State Prison at Folsom, Carmichael Water District, the City of Folsom, the City of Roseville, East Bay Municipal Utility District, El Dorado Irrigation District, Golden State Water Company, Placer County Water Agency, Sacramento County Water Agency, and San Juan Water District for the purpose of sharing costs of the 2008 update to the American River Watershed Sanitary Survey, for a total project cost not to exceed \$175,000, and to provide the option for participating agencies to share costs of follow-up activities on a voluntary basis.
