

ORDINANCE NO. 1627, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1570, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 7, 1951, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAVEL, TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 304, FOURTH SERIES, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED SEC. 68a, PROHIBITING PARKING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1570, Fourth Series, passed April 7, 1951, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 68a:

Sec. 68a: PARKING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive upon or across or to leave standing or cause or permit to be left standing any vehicle upon any privately owned property in the City of Sacramento without the consent of the owner thereof.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
