Subject: Recommendation of Bid Award for Street Light Conversion Program,
Phase IV

Summary

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

Background

On May 24, 1983 the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Street Light Conversion Program, Phase IV, and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on June 14, 1983. Bids received are as shown on the attached Exhibit A. The City reserved the right to award a contract or series of contracts on the basis of the amount bid for each item. The items of the bid correspond to the locations as shown on the attached Exhibit B.

Financial Data

For the subject ongoing project, the City Council has approved in the Engineering Budget \$150,000.00 per year from General Fund, Gas Tax 2106, or General Revenue Sharing funds. The total amount currently available for the project is \$252,645.90. The estimated construction cost for Phase IV of the subject project was \$232,900.00.

- Item 3 - Alhambra Boulevard from I Street to N Street and vicinity.
- Item 4 - Sutterville Road Overcrossing from 22nd Street to 24th Street.
- Item 5 - Fernley Avenue from Traction Avenue to El Monte.
- Item 6 - H Street and I Street from 5th Street to 13th Street.
- Item 7 - F Street and G Street from 7th Street to 13th Street.
- Item 8 - Relocation of electroliers in the vicinity of Fruitridge Road and Stockton Boulevard and South Land Park Drive and 35th Avenue.
