

Sacramento, California,

October 14, 1930.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:30 o'clock P.M. in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman and Chenu.

ABSENT : None.

The minutes of the special session of September 22, 1930, were read and approved as corrected.

The Board examined and passed upon the applications for laborer.

A communication was received from the Machinists Union relative to the employment of Mr. Wall, Assistant Superintendent at the Corporation Yard. The Union contended in the communication that Mr. Wall is performing the work of a machinist and that, therefore, the position should be filled from the list for machinist. Commissioner Maloney moved that a letter be directed to the Recording Secretary of the Machinists Union stating that the case of Mr. Wall has been given full consideration and has been investigated by the Civil Service Board, and that it has been found that the position has been created by ordinance and passed by the City Council, and that at present no eligible list exists for assistant superintendent of the Corporation Yard. Further, that Mr. Wall has been appointed temporarily to the position by the City Manager until such time as the Civil Service Board can prepare and hold an examination for this position, and that data is now being gathered to set up specifications for this position. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weisman. The vote was as follows:

AYES: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman and Chenu.

NOES: None.

The Secretary was instructed to send a copy of the letter received by the Civil Service Board from the Machinists Union, with a copy of the letter sent by the Board in reply, to the City Manager.

Commissioner Maloney moved that a letter be directed to the City Manager requesting that he let the Board have his suggestions as to specifications for assistant superintendent. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weisman. The vote was as follows:


AYES: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman and Chenu.
NOES: None.

A communication was received from Mike Ferris stating he had at one time been employed by the City, laid off, and never re-employed. The Board found that Mr. Ferris worked by only short intervals and had no Civil Service standing.

Adjournment was taken at 9:45 o'clock P.M. to meet again at the call of the Chair.
