SUBJECT: Recommendation of Bid Award for Construction of Play Areas
at Hollywood Park School and Softball Backstop Improvements
at Joaquin Miller Middle School

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On January 27, 1981, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Construction of Play Areas at Hollywood Park School and Softball Backstop Improvements at Joaquin Miller Middle School and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on February 17, 1981. 
FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1979/80 the City Council approved \$66,500 in the Community Services Department's Budget from State Park Funds, General Funds and Park Development Funds for the subject project, of which \$65,185 is currently available. The estimated construction cost is \$46,847.00.

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of Dig It Engineering and Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$45,509.50 be accepted.
