SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Agreement Between City and Various
Subgrantee CETA Title IID Program Entitlements

SUMMARY

For Fiscal Year 1979-80 the Council adopted a budget of \$9,588,650 to support the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) programs for the City and its subgrantees.

FINANCIAL DATA

The City was allocated \$9,171,104 to support the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act programs for FY 1979-80. Of this amount, \$3,893,724 was for Title IID to be used to support the City's and 23 CBO programs. It is estimated that the total expenditure of Title IID funds by the end of September 30, 1980 will be \$3,861,362. These expenditure estimates include the 3 CBO's in this request. It is estimated that \$32,364 will be unallocated as of September 3, 1980.

CONCLUSION

The attached resolution authorizes execution of agreements between the City and various subgrantees for CETA Title IID funding beginning July 1, 1980 to September 30, 1980.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

1. The City Council adopt the attached resolution.
2. The City Council instruct staff to negotiate sub-agent agreements.
