Dear Mr. Smith:

On behalf of the City of Folsom, we would like to take this opportunity to discuss the recent Cable Television Commission's action with respect to award of a franchise to Cablevision.

Galt Councilmember Orville Fletcher, Folsom, Isleton and Galt's representative, has ably represented the three remaining incorporated communities within Sacramento County. In contrast to the initial process utilized for the selection of a cable television firm, these cities' final determination and acceptance was made upon a site visitation. Due to the nature and timing of the second round of selection, it will not be practical to reaffirm the Commission's decision in Folsom. However, we would request the opportunity to conduct a site visitation with Cablevision at a later date. Considering the Cable Television Commission's policy with respect to this matter, we would recommend that a budget appropriation be considered.

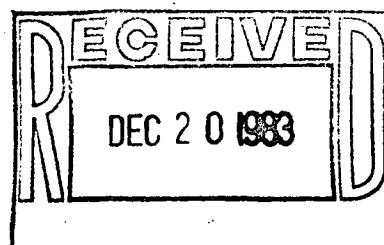


