

ORDINANCE NO. 1157 , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1066, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 10, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 1026, 1031, 1045, 1047, 1052, 1053 AND 1065, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING TO THE SUBDIVISION "PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL" NEW CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY THEREFOR, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1066, Fourth Series, is hereby amended by adding to the Subdivision "PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL" the following:

PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL

2 Attorney, Assistant City \$350 Mo.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary to provide for the salary of the position of "ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY" in the Department of City Attorney.
