AWARDING CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZING BUDGET TRANSFER FOR P/Q ALLEY SEWER AND WATER REPLACEMENT, 16TH TO 17TH ST PROJECT (X14010000)

BACKGROUND

- A. The sewer and water pipelines in P/Q Alley 16th to 17th Streets are in poor condition and in need of replacement.
- B. City staff prepared plans and specifications for the P/Q Alley Sewer and Water Replacement 16th to 17th Street project, to replace approximately 367 linear feet of sewer pipeline and 385 linear feet of water pipeline including sewer services, drain inlets and manholes. The project was advertised and 9 bids were received on December 11, 2013.
- C. The low bidder was CSI Engineering, submitting a bid of \$129,351.49. However, CSI Engineering's bid does not meet the minimum experience requirement specified for water main construction in the request for bids. The owner of CSI Engineering has sufficient experience constructing similar water main projects as a partner with a different company, but that experience is not within the last 5 years, as required in the bid specifications. For this reason, CSI Engineering's bid is nonresponsive, and Navajo Pipelines, Inc., which submitted the second low bid in the amount of \$131,243.44, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- D. The total estimated project cost including design, construction, inspection, and contingency is estimated to be \$195,000 for the P/Q Alley Sewer & Water Replacement 16th to 17th Street project (X14010000). There will be sufficient funds in the project after the completion of a transfer in the amount of \$95,000 from the Residential Water Metering Program (Z14010000, fund 6310) to fund the water main replacement.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the P/Q Alley Sewer and Water Replacement 16th to 17th Street Project are approved, and the contract is awarded to Navajo Pipelines Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$131,243.44.

- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to transfer \$95,000 from the Residential Water Metering Program (Z14010000, fund 6310) to the P/Q Alley Sewer and Water Replacement 16th to 17th Street project (X14010000).
