

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2556

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the public interest and convenience require that the work hereinafter described should be done:

NOW THEREFORE, the said City Council does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of said City Council to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

To close vacate and abandon that portion of that certain Alley lying 1st westerly of 40th Street, as shown on the Map of Elmhurst No. 2 according to the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder on May 19, 1910 in Book 10 of Maps, Map No. 35; lying southerly of the easterly projection of the southerly line of S Street and northerly of the northerly line of the Alley lying between S and T Streets in the City of Sacramento, State of California.

Reserving however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct, sewer, water, and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said alley or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit and will affect and benefit the lands and district herein after described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected, and benefited by said work and improvement, and that, therefore, the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be, and are, hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessable upon said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of

Sacramento, State of California.

The exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by the southerly line of S Street and its easterly projection and the northerly line of Lot 24 of Elmhurst No. 2, (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); on the East by the easterly line of Lots 23 and 24 of said Elmhurst; on the South by the southerly line of Lot 23 of said Elmhurst and its westerly projection and the southerly line of Lot 18 of Williamson Tract, (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); on the West by the westerly line of Lot 18 of said Williamson Tract.

And the said City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, "Street and Highways Code", the "Street Vacation Act of 1941", being an Act of Legislature of the State of California, approved May 13th, 1941.


Notice is hereby given that all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation, may appear before the said City Council, in the Council Chamber, located on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City on May 24th, 1946 at 8:00 o'clock P.M. and be heard in the matter.

The Sacramento Union is hereby designated as the daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, in which this Resolution shall be published; and the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this Resolution in the manner as required by law.
