

ORDINANCE NO. 1033, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 7, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY

OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1014, Fourth Series, passed July 14, 1944, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 7:

Section 7: There is hereby appropriated out of the available revenues, not included in the annual 1944-45 budget, the sum of \$1500.00, to be used for the purpose of employing a co-ordinator to assist in combating juvenile delinquency.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the payment of this money to the Community Welfare Council is necessary for the purpose of employing a co-ordinator to assist in combating juvenile delinquency.
