Plans and Specifications, Contract Award, and Budgetary Adjustments for C Street Crossing Closure Project

BACKGROUND

- A. The closure of the C Street at-grade Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) crossing between 19th and 20th Streets is necessary to satisfy the conditions set forth in the Construction and Maintenance agreement for the Ramona Avenue Extension Project (T15018400).
- B. The C Street Crossing Closure Project will eliminate the at-grade crossing on C Street by the construction of two cul-de-sacs on both sides of the tracks, reducing potential conflicts between vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists, and UPRR trains. The proposed improvements also include new curb, gutter, sidewalks, and drainage improvements.
- C. The project is funded primarily through the Railway-Highway Crossings (Section 130) Program, a federal funding program administered by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). On August 22, 2017, the City of Sacramento accepted and appropriated the Section 130 construction funding in the amount of \$574,595 for the closure of C Street between 19th Street and 20th Street.
- D. The appropriation of an additional \$113,000 of funding from the Railway-Highway Crossings (Section 130) Program (Federal-Fund 3703) is necessary to fully fund the C Street Crossing Closure Project. An amended funding agreement is in process with Caltrans to secure these funds. Local funding in the amount of \$40,000 (Major Street- Fund 2007) will be loaded in advance to allow construction to proceed. These local funds will be reimbursed by the appropriated federal funds.
- E. The project was advertised, and bids were received on May 8, 2019. The bids are shown below:

B&M Builders did not meet the 5% LBE participation requirements and was determined to be non-responsive.

The engineer's construction estimate was \$496,000.

- F. It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, McGuire and Hester.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Plans and Specifications for the C Street Crossing Closure Project (T15018400) are approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to transfer \$40,000 (Major Street Construction Fund, Fund 2007) from available fund balance to the expenditure budget in the Ramona Avenue Extension Project (T15018400) to support the C Street Crossing Closure Project.
- Section 3. Upon Caltrans approval of the additional federal authorization, the City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to increase the revenue and expenditure budgets in the Ramona Avenue Extension Project (T15018400) by \$113,000 (Federal Capital Grants, Fund 3703) in Federal Railway-Highway (Section 130) funding and to transfer \$40,000 (Major Street Construction Fund, Fund 2007) from the expenditure budget in the Ramona Avenue Extension Project (T15018400) to available fund balance.
- Section 4. The construction contract is awarded to McGuire and Hester for an amount not to exceed \$528,304.
- Section 5. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the contract specified above.
