SUBJECT: CITATION AND ARREST AUTHORITY

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: Citywide

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council enact this resolution which updates names of the staff members who are eligible to be granted Citation and Arrest Authority in the Neighborhoods, Planning & Development Services, Housing & Dangerous Buildings Inspections.

SUMMARY:

In accordance with Sacramento City Code, Title 30 and California Penal Code Section 836.5, the City Council is required to issue a resolution assigning specific persons the authority to enforce codes through means of citation and arrest. The attached resolution, provides the names of the specific individuals in Housing & Dangerous Buildings Inspections, who have received the required training and are recommended for Citation and Arrest Authority.

This report modifies the Citation and Arrest Resolution dated June 3, 1997 by updating the names of the individuals qualified in Section 4 for this authority. The report does NOT recommend modification of any ordinance or granting of new authority.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On June 3, 1997, the City Council adopted Resolution 97-285 which granted Citation and Arrest Authority to enforcement staff members in the Neighborhoods, Planning & Development Services Department. The purpose of this authority is to allow enforcement of specific Titles of the Sacramento City Code. The

individuals who enforce these codes have met additional training requirements with the City of Sacramento Police Department and are qualified to be granted Citation and Arrest Authority.

This resolution would repeal and replaced section 4 of Resolution 97-285 enacted on June 3, 1997 with the name of enforcement staff members who are responsible for enforcing Sacramento City Codes related to public nuisance, substandard structures and dangerous structures.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The granting of Citation and Arrest Authority has no financial impact.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:





Section I
