

ORDINANCE NO. 1229, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1168, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 7, 1946, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1946, THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1946, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the GOLF COURSE FUND, the following sum:

The sum of \$5000.00 for repairs and improvements to William Land Golf Course and Clubhouse.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, being an ordinance appropriating money.
