A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AVONDALE/GLEN ELDER WEED AND SEED INCORPORATED, A CALIFORNIA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, TO APPLY FOR FUNDS UNDER THE WEED AND SEED PROGRAM OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE IN YEARS 4 AND 5 OF THE GRANT CYCLE

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento received permission to apply for Weed and Seed Funds for the Avondale/Glen Elder neighborhoods in November 1999 and applied for Department of Justice funds on behalf on these communities

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento was successful in receiving Weed and Seed funds during Years 1 through 3 of the grant cycle and used the funds to establish a variety of programs to benefit the Avondale/Glen Elder communities

WHEREAS, the Avondale/Glen Elder Weed and Seed Incorporated, a California non-profit corporation, has requested that it be authorized to apply for grant funding to the Department of Justice to continue the Weed and Seed program in the Avondale/Glen Elder communities

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

Section 1. The Avondale/Glen Elder Weed and Seed Inc. a California non-profit corporation, is authorized to file grant applications in Years 4 and 5 of the grant cycle to the Department of Justice Weed and Seed program, including asset forfeiture and other special allocations for the Avondale/Glen Elder communities.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to take all reasonable and necessary steps on behalf of the City of Sacramento to assist Avondale/Glen Elder Weed and Seed Inc. in their application for grant funding, including the execution of necessary documents to establish that the City has approved and authorized the filing of the application by the Avondale/Glen Elder Weed and Seed Inc. for grant funding for the continuation of the Weed and Seed program for the Avondale/Glen Elder neighborhoods.
