Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
February 19, 1943

PERMANENT ESTABLISHMENT OF LEAGUE OF CITIES HEAD- QUARTERS IN CITY OF SACRAMENTO

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento highly commends the League of California Cities through its Board of Directors and administrative staff upon its efficiency and effectiveness in safeguarding the Needs and best interests of the Municipalities of this State;
