

THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL

SPECIAL MEETING

MAY 12th,

1924.

Pursuant to call issued by the Mayor on date of May 10th, 1924, the Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at hour of 9,25 o'clock A. M., Mayor Elkus presiding and Roll Call being answered by following members of the City Council:-

Councilmen Elkus, Frazier, Goddard, Kiernan, John H. Miller, Royal Miller.

Call for the Meeting, designating the purpose to be that of appointing a Judge of the Police Court, vacancy occasioned by the death of O. W. Anderson on date of May 10th, 1924, was read to the Council and ordered filed.

Councilman Kiernan introduced the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 117, CITY COUNCIL.

"RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that FRANK L. GAFNEY be and he is hereby appointed POLICE JUDGE OF THE POLICE COURT in and for the City of Sacramento."

Councilman Kiernan moved that foregoing Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Councilman Goddard and there being no further nominations, Roll Call on Resolution resulted as follows:

AYES: Elkus, Frazier, Goddard, Kiernan, John H. Miller, Royal Miller.

ABSENT: Anderson, Bidwell, Brown.

Frank L. Gafney was then sworn and oath of office was ordered filed.

The Mayor thereupon appointed the following as Committee on Resolutions: Councilmen John H. Miller, Kiernan and Goddard.

Councilman Kiernan moved that when Council Adjourn, it Adjourn out of respect to the memory of former Judge of the Police Court, O. W. Anderson. Seconded by Councilman Frazier and carried by following vote:
