

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-445

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 26, 2007

APPROVING SACRAMENTO CITY UNIFIED AGREEMENT

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Parks and Recreation has operated the START (Students Today Achieving Results for Tomorrow) after-school literacy and enrichment program since 1996. A significant portion of the funding for the program comes from the State of California.
- B. The State has approved funding for 13 new elementary school sites and 44 existing school sites. Thirty-seven (37) of those sites are at elementary schools in the Sacramento City Unified School District.
- C. The Sacramento City Unified School District has agreed to allow the City's Sacramento START program to operate the START program at District schools and to pay the City \$63,000 in each of the three years of the agreement.
- D. No General Fund appropriation is required.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement and any extensions, amendments, or other related documents with the Sacramento City Unified School District as necessary for the City to operate the Sacramento START (Students Today Achieving Results for Tomorrow) after-school literacy and enrichment program at 13 new and 24 existing elementary school locations and be paid by the District \$63,000 in each of Fiscal Years (FY) 2006/07, 2007/08 and 2008/09.


