

REGULAR MEETING  
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL  
September 10, 1964

The Honorable City Council met in regular session on this date at the hour of 7:55 o'clock p. . m. , Mayor McKinney presiding and roll call was answered as follows:

Councilmen Christensen, Domich, Marriott, McKinney, Mering, Murphy, Nielsen, Rouse and Talkin.

The City Clerk reported having furnished each member with a copy of proceedings of previous meeting. The minutes of Regular Meeting of September 3, 1964, were ordered approved.

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Councilman Talkin introduced the following resolution moving its adoption:

Resolution congratulating and commending fourteen-year old Leanore Modell upon her inspiring accomplishment of swimming the English Channel. (Reference is hereby made to original resolution adopted on this date and set out in full in Resolution Record 1964, on file in the office of the City Clerk). Seconded by Councilman Christensen and carried by the following vote: 6437

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This having been the date set for hearing and no protests having been received, the City Manager presented and Councilman Mering moved that the following resolution be adopted:

Resolution approving assessment in the matter of construction of a Water Distribution System, complete with all necessary appurtenances, in Lemon Hill Avenue lying between a point located 205 feet West of the Southernly production of the Westerly line of Belleview Avenue and the Northerly production of the center line of 63rd Street; etc. (Reference is hereby made to original resolution adopted on this date and set out in full in Resolution Record 1964, on file in the office of the City Clerk). Seconded by Councilman Nielsen and carried by the following vote: 6438

Resolution granting a revocable permit to Dauger Enterprises, Inc., to use unused street right of way on 16th Avenue and Freeport Boulevard for construction of planter boxes. (Reference is hereby made to original resolution adopted on this date and set out in full in Resolution Record 1964, on file in the office of the City Clerk). Seconded by Councilman Nielsen and carried by the following vote:

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Councilman Rouse returned to the meeting at this time.

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The Assistant City Manager presented a report which was placed on file, relating to a petition signed by parents of the Collis P. Huntington School children requesting retention of the services of Mr. Ernest Paton as a school crossing guard at 24th and Edna Streets. Said report explaining that it has been the City policy to terminate employment of persons in this classification at age 70.

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Mr. Donald L. McCarty, 5644 - 24th Street and three students of the Collis P. Huntington School appeared and spoke in favor of the petition.

Following a lengthy discussion of the matter, Councilman Murphy moved that Mr. Paton be allowed to continue employment temporarily pending a physical examination and pending a review of the City Policy terminating employment of School crossing guards at age 70 by the Council Health, Safety and Morals Committee.

Seconded by Councilman Marriott and carried by the following vote:

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In accordance with recommendation of the City Manager, Councilman Nielsen moved that the work of Howard F. Schetter, for the construction of the floodlighting systems in Tahoe Park and Roosevelt Park Softball Fields, be accepted as completed as of September 2, 1964, and final payment made to contractor.

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Seconded by Councilman Domich and carried by the following vote:

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Controller's and Treasurer's report of fund cash balances as of July 31, 1964, was ordered filed.

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In accordance with recommendation of the Assistant City Manager, Councilman Rouse moved that the work of Wayne Drilling Company for drilling and testing of domestic water well No. 107, be accepted as completed as September 2, 1964, and final payment made to contractor. Seconded by Councilman Nielsen and carried by the following vote:
