

ORDINANCE NO. 1146, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the available funds not heretofore appropriated the sum of \$1,483.70 to "MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES" - RECREATION DEPARTMENT, Budget No. 57.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, being an ordinance appropriating money.
