No. 4890, Richland Street Assessment District

SUMMARY

The object of the Hearing is to hear any protests against the Assessment District and to confirm the Assessment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Engineer filed the Assessment for Improvement Proceeding No. 4890, Richland Street Assessment District, with the City Clerk on March 2nd, 1981. The improvements constructed under this proceeding consist of concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, asphaltic concrete pavement, storm sewers, drainage facilities, sanitary sewers, sewer services, reconstruct water distribution system, reset mail boxes and a street lighting system complete, as described in the Resolution of Intention adopted by the City Council on July 10th, 1979. The City Clerk mailed a Notice of Filing Assessment to each property owner on March 2nd, 1981 and published said Notice in the Sacramento Union on March 6th and 7th, 1981.

FINANCIAL DATA

This project is being financed jointly by the property owners within the district and the City of Sacramento. The City's Contribution is \$421,919.63 and is included in the 1980-81 budget to be funded from General Revenue Sharing funds, 2-11-2600-1022-4820. The balance of the cost of the project, \$154,250.82, is to be assessed against the property owners.




