MINUTES:

Mel Johnson, Director of Public Works, reported that there would be no action on this report at the November 24, 1987 City Council meeting. This item has been rescheduled for the December 1, 1987 meeting. Mr. Johnson stated that the staff report is two fold: 1) To inform the Council of the notification processes for developments with potential FEMA floodplain designations and; 2) Recommending the Mayor be authorized to send a letter to FEMA concerning their remapping effort.

Mr. Johnson also informed the Committee that staff would be asking the Council for support of a resolution requesting increased flood control reservation (100,000 acre-feet) at Folsom Dam in order to provide additional safety to the City of Sacramento. He also explained that a report regarding the flood protection options being studied by the Army Corps of Engineers has been scheduled for the December 15, 1987 meeting.
