

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND AMENDED RE-ASSESSMENT NO. 2606

MAY 11 th, 1950

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for re-assessment of a certain parcel of land in that certain Street Improvement Proceedings numbered RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2606 for the improvement of Streets and Right-of-Ways within and adjacent to Mallegni Terrace, (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), in the City of Sacramento, was filed with the Clerk of the City Council under the provisions of Streets and Highways Code Section 8730 to 8734, and

WHEREAS, the City Council duly and regularly directed that the Superintendent of Streets, ^{to} re-assess said Plat of ground and file his report and amended assessment thereon, and

WHEREAS, the report of FRED J. KLAUS, Superintendent of Streets, and his re-assessment was filed on the 24th day of April, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk, pursuant to the provisions of said Streets and Highways Code, did duly and regularly give notice of the filing of said Report and the fixing of a time for hearing objections to the Report and the Amended Assessment, filed with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, all of said matters are now on for hearing at the meeting held this 11th day of May, 1950, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, and

WHEREAS, no written protests were filed to the same or did anyone appear in person and protest the same,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that notice of this hearing was given in the manner and for the time provided by Law, and that the Report of FRED J. KLAUS, Superintendent of Streets

apportioning and re-assessing Assessments Number 27, in Street Improvement Proceedings No. 2606, according to the benefits to be gained by such original street improvement, into thirty-five (35) parcels, be, and the same is hereby approved and allowed, and that this amended assessment be filed with the City Clerk and the Re-Assessments thereon shall be instead of and in place of the Original Assessment Number 27 as above mentioned.
