
Tom Ray of the Sacramento Kiwanis Club would like to appear before the City Council to discuss a beautification program he has been working on for the City of Sacramento.

Please let Tom know when he can appear before the Council.

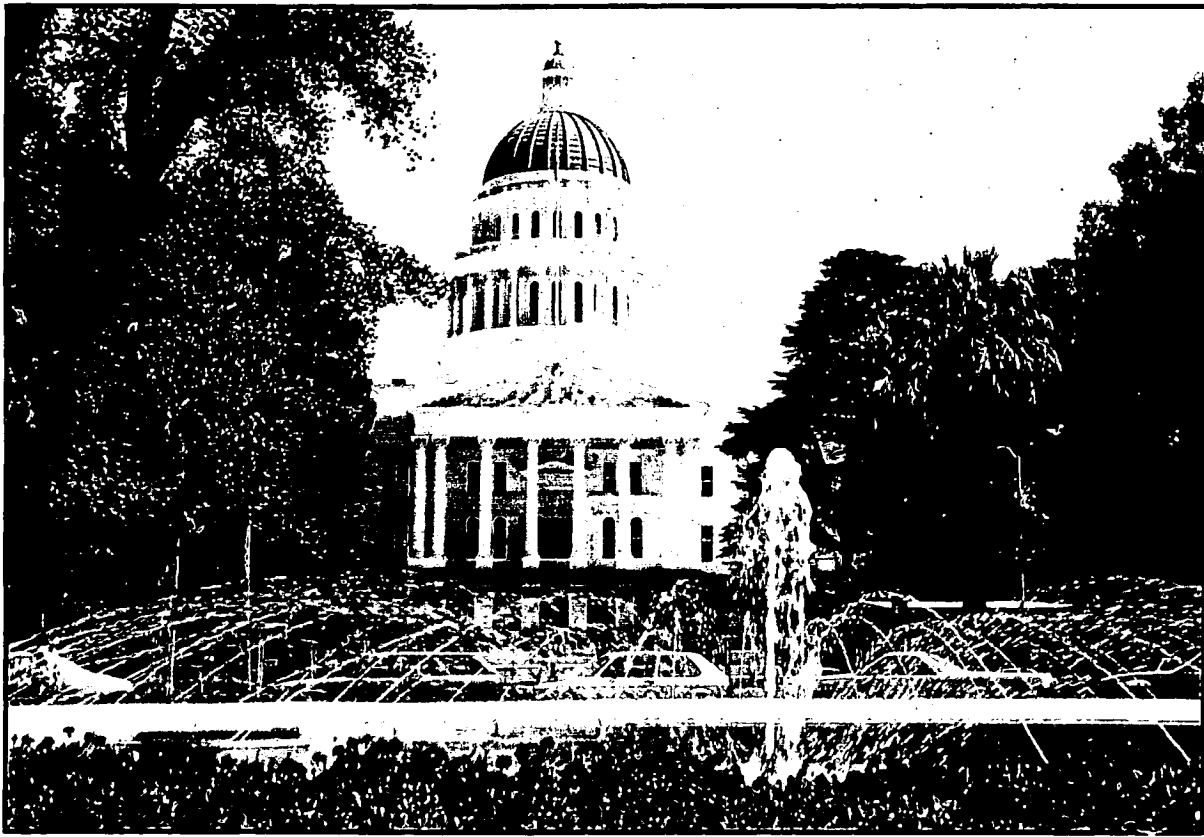

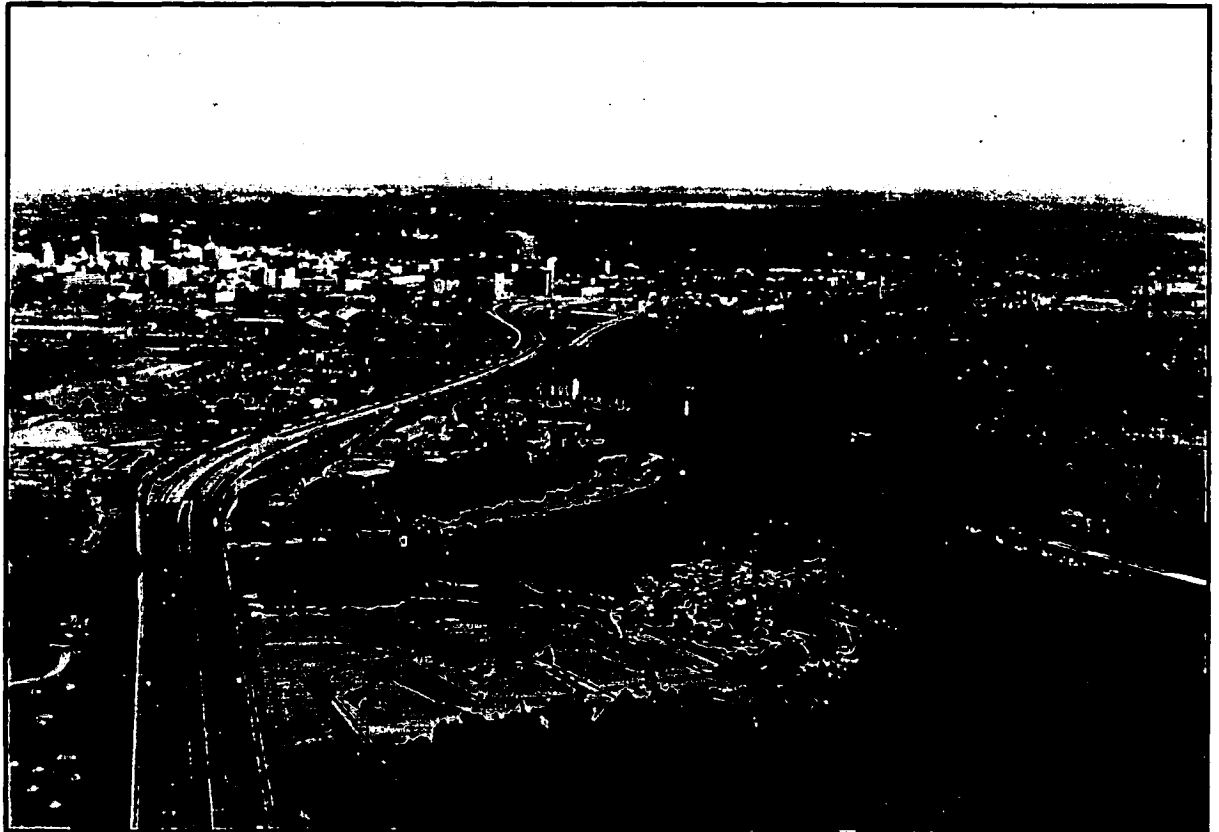

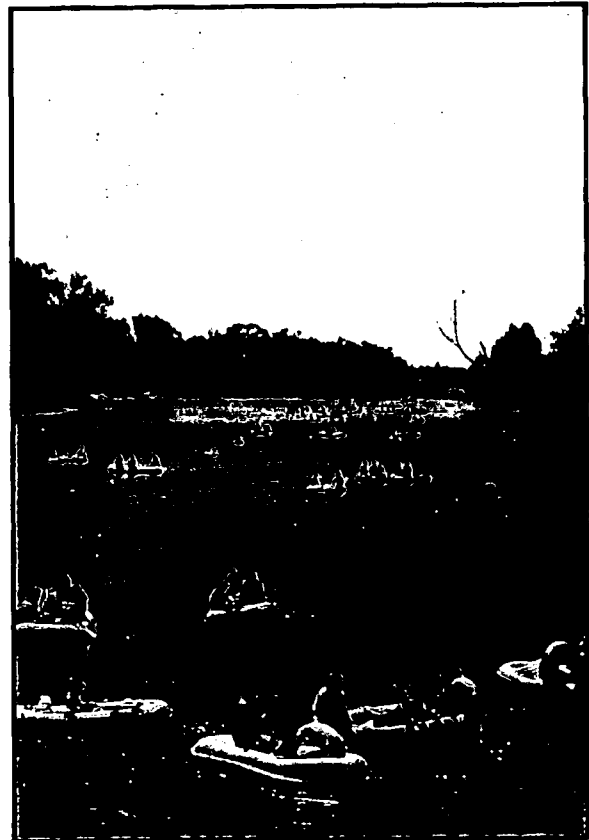
