RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO CREATE A 65TH STREET PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENT PROJECT (M03-185)

WHEREAS, in December 2003, the City Council authorized application and acceptance of the State Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant to support infill development and neighborhood revitalization (Res. 2003-820); and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the 65th Street Transit Village Plan in October 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared the 65th Street Infrastructure Needs Assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Needs Assessment identified streetscape and other pedestrian improvements that would support development consistent with the adopted plan and provide additional benefits for existing and future riders of light rail;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento to:

- 1. Direct staff to prepare a Capital Improvement for the Program consistent with the grant requirements.
- 2. Direct staff to return for City Council approval with a CIP funded with up to \$500,000 from the Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant and \$200,000 from Measure A Focus Area Contingency Funds.
