

ORDINANCE NO. 1462, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE FIVE (5) MOTORCYCLES AND FIVE (5) VETRIC MOTORCYCLE RADIO RECEIVERS IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, FIVE (5) MOTORCYCLES, for use by the Police Department.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager is further authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids, FIVE (5) VETRIC MOTORCYCLE RADIO RECEIVERS, for use by the Police Department.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of the City of Sacramento to acquire immediately said motorcycles and radio receiving sets for use in the Police Department to fulfill their requirements.
