

RESOLUTION No. 854

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 7, 1949.


WHEREAS, the SACRAMENTO YACHT CLUB heretofore petitioned the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, for the privilege of constructing two (2) floating wharves, two (2) walkways, one (1) six-pile dolphin, and a mooring of the Club's house barge, on the east side of the Sacramento River, near Mile 57.9 and approximately 600 feet below the foot of Broadway, at Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, a permit to make this installation was granted by the said Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, on September 30, 1949, and a permit has been requested of the City of Sacramento to install these facilities on said east bank of the Sacramento River opposite the Miller Park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable permit be, and the same is hereby, granted to the SACRAMENTO YACHT CLUB to install the facilities above mentioned in the Sacramento River opposite Miller Park and permit said club the privilege of ingress and egress to the facilities above mentioned.

This permit is granted upon the application of the Sacramento Yacht Club and on the condition that said club hold the City of Sacramento harmless from all causes of action which may arise out of or in connection with the granting of this permit.
