

RESOLUTION No. 87


Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 2, 1972

WHEREAS, on the morning of February 14, 1972, the Crocker National Bank at 2300 Florin Road was robbed of \$1,375 by an armed female, and

WHEREAS, Carl H. Graves, a Fire Engineer of the Sacramento Fire Department, did note said robbery and did alertly follow the suspect from the bank, retaining her in his sight until officers of the Sacramento Police Department, assisted by his direction, effected the arrest of the suspect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Sacramento, Honorable Members in Session this second day of March, 1972, does hereby commend the initiative and resourcefulness of Carl H. Graves; his direct action resulted in the apprehension of a bank robbery suspect who otherwise might not have been taken into custody.
