

Sacramento, California.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:30 o'clock P.M., in the office of the City Manager, City Hall, President Mason presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Mason, Chenu and Weisman.  
ABSENT: None.

Minutes of special meeting of December 14th were read and approved as read:

The subject of the resignation in the Police Department of patrolman Lester M. Davies was discussed and application filed by the patrolman November 1st, 1926, was reviewed.

The President called attention to the admission by Mr. Davies that his real name was Lester M. Sleep.

On motion of Commissioner Weisman seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, the application of Mr. Davies above referred to was referred to the City Attorney for an opinion as to whether or not it would be proper for the Civil Service Board to prefer charges against this former patrolman for perjury on account of falsifying his name in application filed with the Civil Service Board.

The Board thereupon proceeded to review in detail the examination papers of candidates for patrolmen and uniform fireman.

Upon motion of Commissioner Chenu seconded by Commissioner Weisman and unanimously carried, it was the sense of the Board that the ratings given on these examination papers in the educational test for patrolmen and uniform firemen having been examined separately and individually be approved and confirmed.
