

Sacramento, California.
September 22, 1930.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:15 O'clock P.M. in their office room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

Present: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Absent : Commissioners Weisman.

The minutes of the special session of September 12, 1930 were read and approved as read.

Mr. Baccellia appeared before the Board with reference to his request for reinstatement. The record in this case showed that Mr. Baccellia left the City service of his own accord. The City Attorney held in the prior hearing of this case that resignation severed this employee from the service, and that reentry could only be had by examination. Commissioner Maloney moved that the request of Mr. Baccellia be denied. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Noes: None

Absent: Commissioners Weisman.

The Board next gave consideration to the various procedures and practices now being followed in the City service and their relation to the proper functioning of the Civil Service Department. Commissioner Maloney moved that the Secretary be instructed to communicate with the City Manager and endeavor to arrange for a meeting at which he might be present to discuss matters affecting Civil Service, preferably Monday September 29, 1930. The Motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Noes: None

Absent: Commissioner Weisman.

The Board gave consideration to the case of the Committee that appeared before this body September 12, 1930, with reference to the establishment of the position of Fire Inspector. Commissioner Maloney moved that a communication be directed to the Chief ~~Engineer~~ of the Fire Department explaining that a Committee had appeared before the Civil Service Board requesting that the position of Fire Inspector be created and that this Board has the matter under advisement and requesting an opinion from the Chief ~~Engineer~~ as to the adviseability of such a move. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Noes: Commissioner ~~None~~.

Absent: Commissioner Weisman.

The payroll and temporary appointment report covering Mr. E.B. Chappell and Mr. Wall and designating them as Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent respectively was considered by the Board. Commissioner Maloney moved that this matter be referred back to the City Manager, with the explanation that this Board has no record of these positions being created and that approval has been withheld pending further advice. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Noes: None

Absent: Commissioner Weisman.

The request of John Gubel for an extension of his leave of

absence from September 1, 1930 for a period of 90 days was considered. Commissioner Maloney moved that this request be granted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.

Noes: None

Absent: Commissioner Weisman.

The Board next set the dates for the accepting of applications for Examination for the following positions; Policeman. Uniform Fireman and Laborer. Commissioner Maloney moved that applications be opened for Policeman, Fireman and Laborer, October 1, 1930. and closed for Laborer October 11, 1930, and for Policeman and Fireman November 8, 1930. That the strength and Agility test for Fireman and Policeman be held November 15, and 16th 1930, and the Written examination For Policeman and Fireman be held November 20 and 22 1930. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

Ayes: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu,

Noes: None

Absent: Commissioner Weisman.

Adjournment was taken at 9:40 O'clock P.M. to meet again at the call of the chair.
