RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REVIEW AND APPROVE HIGH TIMES' REQUEST TO HOLD THE CANNABIS CUP EVENT AT CAL EXPO

BACKGROUND

- A. As of January 1, 2018, the State of California began issuing State temporary cannabis event licenses, which authorize events with onsite adult-use cannabis sales and consumption at County fairgrounds, pursuant to the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA) (specifically, California Business and Professions Code section 26200).
- B. MAUCRSA states that a Temporary Cannabis Event license will only be issued by the State in local jurisdictions that authorize such events.
- C. High Times is seeking a state temporary cannabis event license for an event called the Cannabis Cup at the Cal Expo facilities in Sacramento. The event is scheduled for May 4th and 5th of 2018.
- D. High Times is also seeking the City's authorization to hold the Cannabis Cup event.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: The City Council finds and determines that the background statements A through D are true.
- Section 2: The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or the city manager's designee, to review and approve the request from High Times for the City's one-time authorization to hold the Cannabis Cup event on May 4th and 5th of 2018 at the Cal Expo facilities, located at 16000 Exposition Boulevard in Sacramento, California.
