



RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO,
CALIFORNIA:

That pursuant and subject to all the terms, conditions and provisions of the Public Health Act of the State of California, approved March 23, 1907, and all amendments thereto, application by this City be made to the State Board of Public Health of the State of California, for a permit to construct and operate a primary sewage treatment plant consisting of grit removal; screening; pre-aeration and grease removal; primary sedimentation with discharge of effluent to Sacramento River; settled sludge to digestion tanks with heating; elutriation; vacuum filtration and furnace drying. Plant to be located on the Teichert property in the north half of Sec. 26, T 8 N, R 4 E, M.D.B. & M. to serve Sacramento Metropolitan Area.

That the City Manager of said City Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to cause the necessary data to be prepared, and investigations to be made, and in the name of said City to sign and file such application with the said State Board of Public Health.
