ORDINANCE NO. 1612, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE THE MOTOR OF PUMP NO. 7, AT SUMP NO. 2, REWOUND, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to have the Motor of Pump 7, at Sump No. 2, rewind, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, at a cost of approximately \$2700.00 to be appropriated out of BOND SEWER FUND; such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate need of having said motor rewind and placed in service as soon as possible, in order that Sump 2 may be in full operation during the winter peak load.
