

Resolution of Award No. 2504

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 9th day of February 19 45, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To L. G. LENTZ

at the prices specified in his proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of the alley between "R" and "S" STREETS, from the easterly line of 21st Street, to the westerly line of 22nd Street, and improving 21st Street from a point 5 feet north of the southerly line of the alley between R and S Streets to a point 5 feet north of the northerly line of said alley.

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2504, passed and adopted by said City Council on December 26th 19 44, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.
