

ORDINANCE NO. 977, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 65, THIRD SERIES, PASSED JANUARY 31, 1913, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO DEAL, PLAY OR CARRY ON, OR OPEN OR CONDUCT, OR TO BET AT OR AGAINST ANY GAME PLAYED WITH CARDS, DICE, DOMINOES, OR ANY DEVICE, FOR MONEY, CHIPS, CHECKS OR CREDIT, OR TO RENT ANY ROOM, PLACE OR SPACE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CARRYING ON ANY OF SAID PROHIBITED GAMES, OR TO VISIT ANY SUCH PLACES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 65, Third Series, passed January 31, 1913, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to deal, play, or carry on, open, or cause to be opened, or to conduct, either as owner or employee, whether for hire or not, any game of faro, monte, roulette, lansquenet, rouge-et-noir, rondo, tan, fan-tan, stud-horse poker, seven-and-a-half, twenty-one, hokey-pokey, or any banking or percentage game played with cards, dice, dominoes, or any device, for money, chips, checks, credit, or other representative of value, or to bet at or against any of said prohibited games.


SECTION 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 65, Third Series, passed January 31, 1913, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Any person who shall, within the limits of the City of Sacramento, violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety.
