RESOLUTION NO. 3526 ORDERING THE CONSTRUCTION  
OF SIDEWALKS ON PORTION OF PERKINS WAY,  
FREEPORT BOULEVARD TO WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD  
COMPANY RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, it appears from affidavits on file in the office of the City Clerk that NOTICE has been given by mail and by posting, as prescribed in Chapter 27, Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California (Improvement Act of 1911), setting the time and place when and where objections or protests to the construction of sidewalks on the Portions of the North and South side of Perkins Way between Freeport Boulevard and the Western Pacific Railroad Company Right of Way, according to the Resolution adopted heretofore, would be heard by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, no protests have been filed, Now Therefore be it

RESOLVED: That sidewalks shall be constructed on said portions of Perkins Way, as specified by the Superintendent of Streets.
