SUBJECT: Program Supplement Between City of Sacramento and State of California  
for the Reconstruction of San Juan Road.

SUMMARY

Attached is a proposed Program Supplement between the City of Sacramento and the State of California covering participation in the reconstruction of San Juan Road from .1 mile west of the West Drainage Canal to .3 mile east of the West Drainage Canal. The City Engineer recommends that the Program Supplement be executed by the City.

BACKGROUND

This Program Supplement No. 17 provides for certain Federal Aid safety improvements to be constructed on San Juan Road from .1 mile west of the West Drainage Canal to .3 mile east of the West Drainage Canal. This is a supplement to a Local Agency - State Master Agreement for Federal Aid (City Agreement No. 77003, State Agreement No. 03-5002).

The improvements consist of realigning San Juan Road over the West Drainage Canal where a dangerous "S" curve exists and reconstructing the asphalt pavement for a total distance of about .4 mile.

The City is preparing the plans, specifications, and estimate for the project. The State will administer the construction contract.

FINANCIAL

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$122,000.00 (\$100,000.00 construction and \$22,000.00 preliminary engineering). Federal funds would amount to \$104,350.00 and State 169.1 Matching Funds would be \$17,650.00. There will be no cost to the City.


The City Engineer recommends that the Mayor and the City Clerk be authorized to execute the Program Supplement by passage of the attached resolution.
