

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND
AMENDED ASSESSMENT NO. 2714

WHEREAS, a petition for an Amended Assessment of a certain parcel of land assessed in that certain Street Improvement Proceeding Numbered, RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2714 for the construction of

STORM SEWER in East Sandburg Drive from the Easterly line of Orchard Terrace Unit No. 2 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the center line of Moddison Avenue; Moddison Avenue from the center line of East Sandburg Drive to the center line of South Sandburg Drive; Right-of-Way, owned by the City of Sacramento, as contained in Deed, dated April 15 th, 1948, Recorded May 3rd, 1948 in Book No. 1484 of Official Records, Instrument No. 18690, as deeded by Louis D. Carlson and Ada H. Carlson, his wife, and John Sandburg and Minnie E. Sandburg, his wife, to the City of Sacramento, (a municipal corporation),

in the City of Sacramento, was filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento under the provisions of Streets and Highways Code Sections 8730 to 8734 inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento duly and regularly directed the Superintendent of Streets, to file his Report and Amended Assessment together with a Map showing how said parcel of land has been subdivided, and

WHEREAS, FRED J. KLAUS, Superintendent of Streets, filed with the City Clerk a Report and Amended Assessment together with a Map showing how said parcel has been subdivided, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk pursuant to the provisions of said Streets and Highways Code, did duly and regularly give notice of the filing of said Report and the fixing of a time for hearing objections to the Report and the Amended Assessment and Map so filed, and

WHEREAS, said Report, Amended Assessment and Map are now on for hearing at the meeting held this 15th day of June, 1950 in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, and


WHEREAS, no written protests were filed to the same or did anyone appear in person and protest the same,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that notice of this hearing was given in the manner and for the time provided by Law, and that the Report and Amended Assessment of Fred J. Klaus, Superintendent of Streets, filed with the City Clerk on May 27th, 1950, apportioning Assessment No. 424 and Assessment Number 178 of the Amended Assessment No. 1, in Street Improvement Proceedings No. 2714, according to the benefits to the several parts of the lands originally affected by said Assessment No. 424 and said Assessment Number 178 of Amended Assessment No. 1 into Ninety Two (92) parcels, be, and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and that the City Clerk file said Amended Assessment with the Auditor of the City of Sacramento and that collections of unpaid installments of said Original and Amended Assessment No. 1 shall be made in accordance therewith as provided by Law.
