RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, Herbert Walter and Lillian Walter, his wife; and Thomas A. Spalding and Elsie J. Spalding, his wife, ----- have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Quitclaim Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:
