**APPROVAL OF 2003 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION AGENDA**


**WHEREAS:** In 2003, the 108<sup>th</sup> Congress will initiate the reauthorization of the nation's transportation funding programs administered by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

**WHEREAS:** The City of Sacramento has in the past adopted Federal Transportation Agenda documents as a method of setting forth the City's priorities and funding requests for projects in which a federal interest has been identified


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

The 2003 Federal Transportation Agenda to contain the following priority projects and funding requests is hereby approved:

- North Central Business District Access \$11 million
- Folsom & Power Inn Area Improvements \$10 million
- Sacramento Intermodal Station \$5 million
- R Street Corridor Project \$1.5 million
- Interstate 5 Riverfront Reconnection
- Cosumnes Extension, Franklin to I-5; Interchange with I-5
