SUMMARY

Granite Construction has completed the above referenced project under Project Number 2615, Council Contract No. C-85023 dated September 11, 1985. This work was completed November 13, 1985 at a cost of \$268,800.00 and acceptance is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On September 3, 1985 Council awarded to Granite Construction the contract for loading, hauling and unloading clayey soil to the City Sanitary Landfill. The general scope of the project was to obtain clayey material for the final cover of the 28th Street Landfill to fulfill one of the requirements of the State Water Resources Control Board.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the project be accepted, the Notice of Completion and Acceptance of Work be filed with the County Recorder, and the final payment be authorized.
