

ORDINANCE NO. 1571, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE CERTAIN WORK DONE AT THE FILTRATION PLANT, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$4721.50 TO COVER COST OF SAID WORK, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to have the following work done at the Filtration Plant, to-wit: Reconstruction of two of the low lift De Laval Pumps, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost of said work to be \$4,721.50.

SECTION 2: That the sum of \$4,721.50 is hereby appropriated out of WATER DEPARTMENT SURPLUS to cover the cost of said work.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate need of said pumps by the City in the operation of said Filtration Plant and, further, that the DeLaval Company is the only company able to furnish the required parts.


