The petition provides for a Waiver of the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931.


Approval of the petition by adoption of the attached Resolution provides that the City Council finds that the property owners have WAIVED the above mentioned Act.

This project is to be paid for in its entirety by the property owners within the proposed assessment district.


RECOMMENDATION
