

RESOLUTION No. 289

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
February 21, 1947

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF SACRAMENTO:

That BUTTER CREAM BAKING COMPANY be, and it is hereby, granted a revocable permit to construct a continuation of its existing awning, approximately 30' in length on the bakery building and over flour elevator entrance, on the north side of alley located between 28th and 29th, J and K Streets; also permit to erect a continuation of awning on south side of alley, approximately 110 feet, along garage building. The awnings to be approximately 14' above alley pavement and constructed of structural steel members and corrugated iron covering.

This permit is granted upon the condition that said BUTTER CREAM BAKING COMPANY protect and save harmless the City of Sacramento from all damage, costs, and causes of action which might arise from this construction.

This permit is granted in pursuance of application heretofore filed by said Butter Cream Baking Company.
