

ORDINANCE NO. / 1482 , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 861, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 19, 1940, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN SALES BY THE CITY OF CITY OWNED REAL PROPERTY WHICH HAS BEEN ACQUIRED BY THE CITY OTHER THAN BY REASON OF SALE FOR TAXES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 5.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 861, Fourth Series, passed April 19, 1940, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto, numbered Section 5, to read as follows:

" Section 5: After publishing a notice for atleast four (4) days in the official newspaper of the city, giving the time and place when it will consider selling certain real property to a public agency, the Council may, by a four-fifths vote, grant, convey or quitclaim to the state, or to any city, school district, irrigation, flood control, Municipal Utility District, or other special district, any real property belonging to the city, upon such terms and conditions as are agreed upon, without first complying with any other provisions of this ordinance; provided the said property to be granted, conveyed or quitclaimed is not required for the city's use."

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento and shall take effect 30 days from and after its passage.
